Jason Segel



In Forgetting Sarah Marshall, his debut as a screenwriter and leading man, Jason Segel plays Peter Bretter, a songwriter who retreats to Hawaii after being dumped by his famous girlfriend (Kristen Bell) only to find her vacationing at the same resort with her new rockstar boyfriend.

Jason Jordan Segel was born January 18, 1980 in Los Angeles. In high school, he was a member of a state champion basketball team and appeared in local theater productions. He was discovered by a Paramount casting agent during one of these early plays.

He was cast in 1998's *Can't Hardly Wait*. Though his part was ultimately cut from the film, but he appeared later that year as a high-strung college freshman in the black comedy *Dead Man on Campus* and the volatile leader of Salt Lake City's punk contingency in *SLC Punk!*

The next year, he appeared in *New Jersey Turnpikes* and played hangdog drummer Nick Andopolis on **Judd Apatow's** short-lived high school series "Freaks and Geeks." After his show's cancellation, Segel starred in Apatow's pilot "North Hollywood" and played one of a trio of college scam artists in *Slackers* (2002). After the network turned him down for one of the show's leads, he had a recurring role as a clingy boyfriend on Apatow's "Undeclared."

Around this time, Segel also sold his still-unproduced first screenplay. In 2003, he appeared in 11:14 and the short film Certainly Not a Fairytale. The next year, he starred opposite Mark Valley in the ABC pilot "Harry Green and Eugene." He also appeared in Jenna Fischer's short film LolliLove and began a recurring stint on "CSI."

The studio blocked him from appearing (as Apatow wanted) in *The 40 Year-Old Virgin*, and Segel instead found success in 2005 on TV. He guest starred on "Alias" and was cast as Midwestern transplant Marshall Eriksen on the CBS comedy "How I Met Your Mother."

Last year, Segel played one of **Seth Rogen's** more lecherous friends in *Knocked Up* (2007). He will next star in *I Love You, Man* with **Paul Rudd** and *Five-Year Engagement*, which he is co-writing with *Sarah Marshall* director **Nicholas Stoller**, with whom he is also writing a new *Muppets* movie.

As *Heeb Magazine's* coverboy, Segel will attend the celebration of the magazine's first ever Hollywood Issue Release Party on Wednesday, April 9 at Gallery 819 Von Dutch.
